Am I eligible?

You may be eligible for the AMEP if you:

- ✓ arrived in Australia in the last 6 months
- ✓ hold a family, skilled, humanitarian, spousal or approved temporary visa*
- ✓ have little or no English speaking, reading or writing skills
- ✓ are aged over 18 (some migrant youth aged 15-17 may also be eligible.)
